A regular meeting of the City of Cody Contractors' Board was held by phone conference on Thursday, April 22, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.

Ray Lozier called the meeting to order at 12:11 p.m.

Jake Schrickling made motion, seconded by Heidi Rasmussen to approve the agenda for the April 22, 2021 meeting. Vote on the motion was unanimous, motion passed.

Heidi Rasmussen made a motion, seconded by Jake Schrickling to approve the minutes from the February 25, 2021 meeting. Vote on the motion was unanimous, motion passed.

Sean Collier reviewed the Contractor Application for Sagebrush Construction for a General Contractor License. The license will be for residential project.
