A regular meeting of the City of Cody Contractors' Board was held at the Holiday Inn Board Room, Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, November 15, 2012 at 12:00 p.m.

Chairman Roy Holm called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

Gerald Stroh made a motion seconded by Gene Kelly to approve the minutes of the October 25, 2012 regular meeting. Vote was unanimous, motion carried.

Gerald Stroh made a motion seconded by Hal Lee to approve Capitol Roofing Service for a Class C Roofing and Sheet metal Contractor's License. Vote was unanimous, motion carried.

Discussion Items:

1. Scott King updated the board regarding the adoption process of the 2012 Building Code.
2. The building official reviewed the Wyoming Conference of Building Officials that he attended with Assistant Inspector Evan Bennett last weekend. The class regarding Type 1 & 2 Hoods was especially informative. The conference was well attended.
3. Three board member terms are ending, Merle Nielsen, Gene Kelly and Tom Quick. All three expiring members have submitted their re-application. The council will review the applications in December with appointments scheduled for January.
4. Councilman Charles Cloud's term is ending this year. The Council will appoint a new representative to the Contractors' Board in January as well.
5. The board requested and received an update regarding their denial of the hospital fencing contractor's license.
6. The roofing project on the Lutheran Church was discussed.
7. Several current projects in town were reviewed.
8. As Cody Laboratories' licensed electrician, Jason Piccoli, is no longer employed, their license will be closed.
